Job Description

Position Summary

The Family Ministries Pastor, working under the Executive Pastor, oversees the vision, direction and execution of the children and youth ministries ("Family Ministries") at Soul Sanctuary ("Soul"). The Family Ministries Pastor oversees and provides executive leadership to Family Ministries staff. The Family Ministries Pastor assumes the responsibility of establishing the vision, direction and culture of these ministries. This position is a full-time, salaried position.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Build a discipling culture in Family Ministries that reflects the vision, mission and family values of Soul
- Build and implement a disciple-making strategy for Family Ministries which prioritizes the role of parents as the primary disciple-makers of their children
- Provide leadership and guidance for Family Ministries staff
- Oversee the recruitment and equipping of servant leaders to carry significant responsibility in Family Ministries
- Develop, communicate and enforce policies pertinent to Family Ministries, including the revision and implementation of pre-existing Child Protection Policies
- Oversee the planning and execution of outreach events, workshops and community engagement initiatives for Family Ministries
- Oversee the planning and execution of summer camps
- Plan and implement Family Ministry goals and objectives
- Provide financial oversight of Family Ministries
- Provide pastoral care to the Soul community building relationships and providing pastoral support to children, parents and family units
- Be an integral member of the Soul Staff team and the Soul community through participation in Soul Gatherings, initiatives and Life Groups
- All other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- Prior children's or youth ministry related work experience
- Bachelor's Degree or equivalent, course work or concentrations children or youth ministry
- Excellent administrative and communication skills, demonstrated ability to manage staff
- A team player who works effectively with staff and servant leaders
- Desire to learn new technologies in a ministry context
- Demonstrated Christian character and depth of spiritual maturity
- Clear Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector checks
- Doctrinal alignment with Soul Sanctuary and the Pentacostal Assemblies of Canada.
